What is HomeLinks?

-HomeLinks is a program to help families learn Catholic theology and make concrete connections to family life.

-HomeLinks provides parents with the knowledge and skills to talk about and put into action the theology of our Church.

-HomeLinks is a way for families to connect and stay connected.



Who is HomeLinks For?

-HomeLinks primary audience is parents. We're here to give you the help you need to have your family model our faith.

-HomeLinks is also a great way for grandparents, aunt and uncles, and godparents to be involved in their Catholic family life.

-Each 30-40 minute HomeLinks session provides parents with practical ideas for use in the home, engaging speakers, and easy to understand theology, all to help disciple their families.

How Does HomeLinks Work?

-Each week, a new HomeLinks session is hosted on our Households of Faith website. Families log in to access the sessions.

-The cost is only \$25 for a family to get access to 18 great family-centered education sessions.

-Parishes or schools can opt for a "institutional license" to provide this program to all families!
